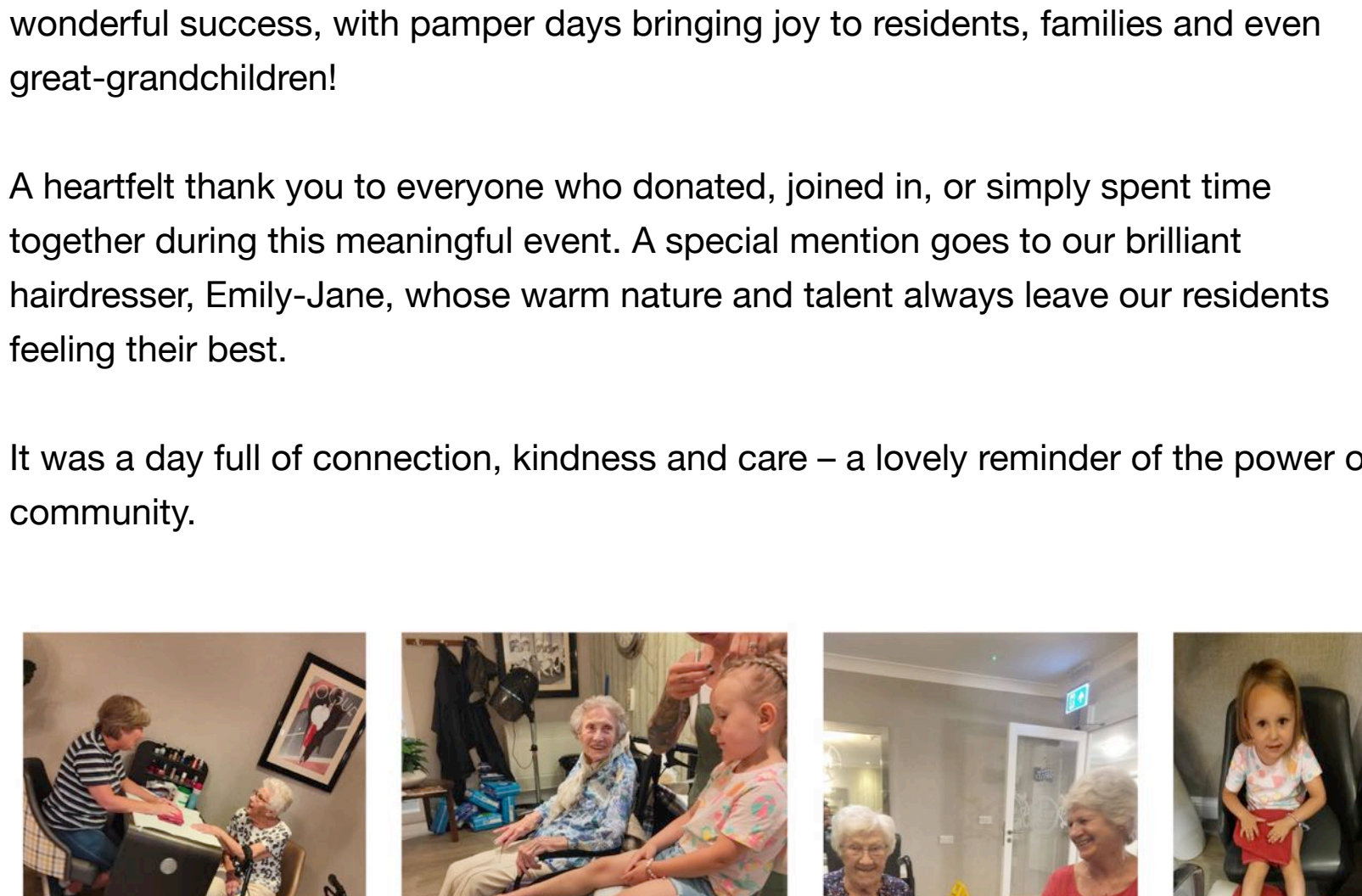


Supporting Make-A-Wish UK

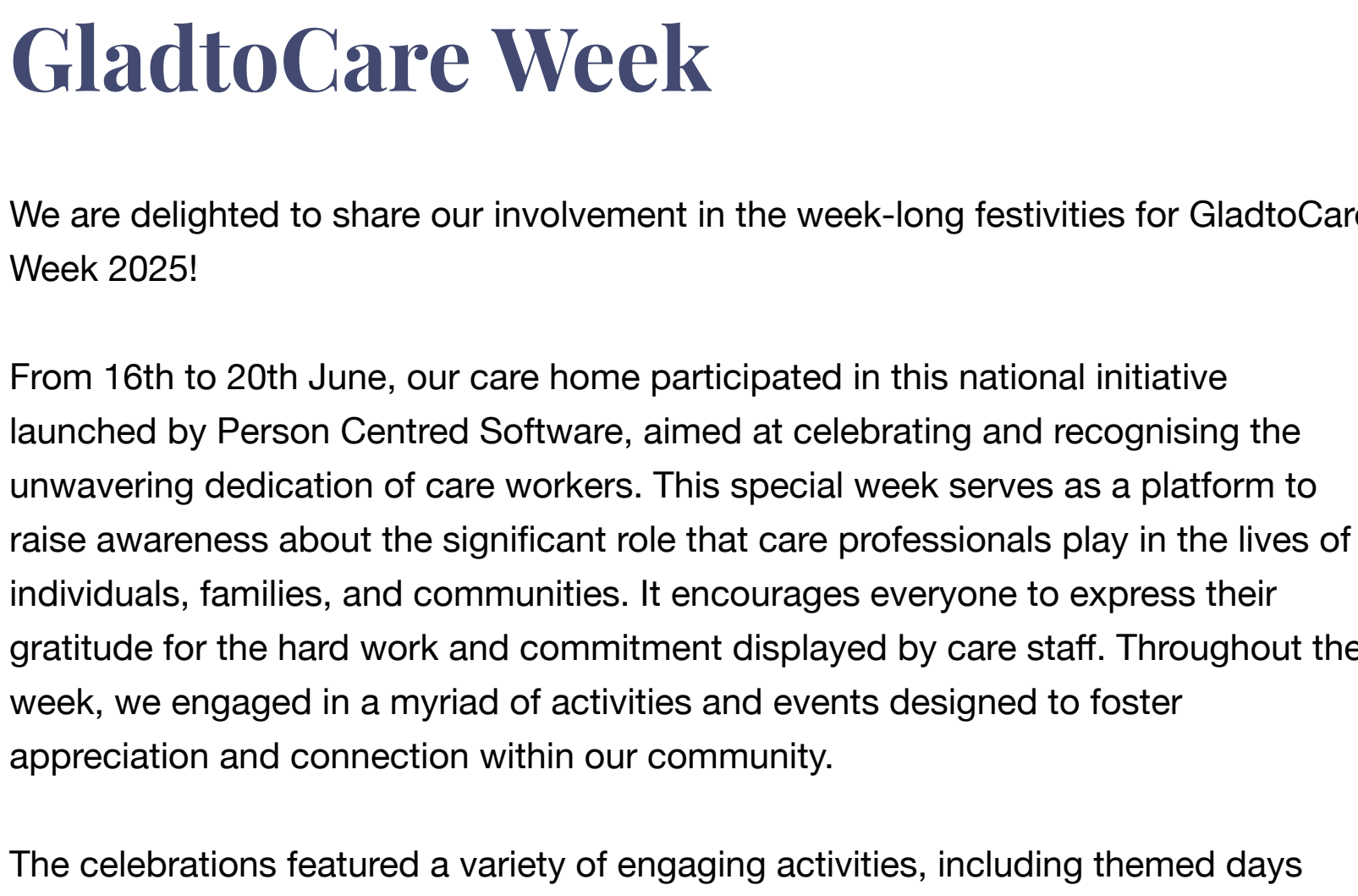
