We also had the pleasure of helping one of our residents celebrate a very special birthday with a surprise that brought back some wonderful memories.

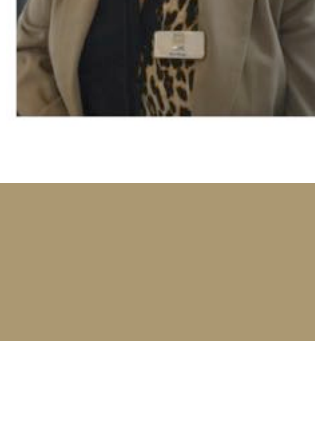
Thank you to our residents, families, friends and team for helping make these occasions so enjoyable. We hope you enjoy looking back at some of our summer highlights.
